

Ratio Practice - Problem 2.1 Fab Five Fruits

Amy's Ice Cream heard about Freddy's fruit smoothies at Camp Kiwi and offered to make smoothies for the campers. Amy's Ice Cream has a similar recipe for the smoothies but will add their famous french vanilla ice cream.

They will use 1 quart of ice cream for every pineapple.

They will use 2 peaches for every pineapple.

They will use 3 bananas for every peach.

There will be twice as many bananas as coconuts.
